

Quotation Marks " " Character

To enter " " quotation marks into the command line press and hold **Shift** and **"** .

Description

With " " quotation marks you can enter text strings into the command line.



Important:

If you do not enter text strings using " " quotation marks, the console interprets the text strings as a command, which can lead to incorrect results.

Examples

- To label a macro by using the command line enter into the command line:



```
[Channel]> Label Macro 3 "on"
```

Macro 3 is labeled as "on".

-
- To assign an info text for cue 1 enter into the command line:



```
[Channel]> Assign Cue 1 /info="run after music stops"
```

Cue 1 contains the information "run after music stops".
