



## Align Keyword

To enter the Align keyword in the command line, use one of the options:

- Press **Align**
- Type **Align**
- Type the shortcut **AI**

## Description

The Align keyword is a function keyword used to toggle through the align modes of the attribute encoders.

- To toggle through the modes, repeatedly press **Align**.

Align Modes	Index Number
Off	0
/	1
<	2
>	3
><	4
<>	5

## Syntax

**Align [Mode]**

**Align [Index Number]**



## Examples

- To set the encoders to the first align mode, type:

**[M|A]** User name[Fixture]> Align "<"

- To turn off any align mode, type:

**[M|A]** User name[Fixture]> Align 0
