



## /Path Option Keyword

To enter the **/Path** option keyword in the command line, use one of the options:

- Type **/Path**
- Type the shortcut **/Pa**

## Description

The **/Path** option keyword defines the folder path where an imported or exported file is saved.



### Hint:

- Enter a path beginning with a letter or number if the path is incorporated with the default folder structure.
- Enter a path beginning with the forward-slash (/) character if the path begins at the root of the device.
- Entering a path that does not already exist creates the necessary folders.

## Syntax

**[Function] [Object] ["Object\_Name" or Object\_Number] (If Drive [Drive\_Number]) /Path "The/Path/To/My/Files"**

## General Keywords

General keywords that use the **/Path** option keyword:

- **Export keyword**
- **Import keyword**

## Example

- To export macro 1, labeled "test," to a folder labeled "myfavorites" at the root of the first connected USB drive, type:



```
User name[Fixture]> Export Macro 1 "test" If Drive 2 /Path "/myfavorites"
```
